

Japanese Basic Sentence Structure

1. Subject wa Predicate desu
2. Subject wa Predicate dewa arimasen
3. Subject wa Predicate desuka?
4. Subject wa Dare= Who desuka?
5. Subject wa Nan =What desuka?
6. Subject mo Predicate desu
7. Subject wa PERSON no Object/Thing desu

Example

1. Watashi wa Gakusei desu (I am a student)
Watashi wa Kanada-jin desu (I am Canadian)
2. Watashi wa sensei dewa arimasen (I am not a teacher)
Kanojyo wa Amerika-jin dewa arimasen (She is not American)
3. Anata wa isya desuka? (Are you a doctor?)
4. Kare wa dare desuka? (Who is he?)
5. Kore wa nan desuka? (What is this?)
6. Karera mo Isya desu (They are also doctors)
7. Kore wa watashi no hon desu (This is my book)
